

1 Kahua Overview

GSA's new project management and collaboration tool

What is Kahua?

- Commercial off-the-shelf, web-based software configured for GSA
- Access via desktop, web browser or mobile device
- FedRAMP approved, supporting CUI/Sensitive Building Information (formerly SBU)
- Controlled access to project information
- Integrates with PBS data sources
- Includes the full project lifecycle
- Accommodates different project types and sizes
- Allows for stakeholder collaboration



What does Kahua offer?

- Get project information in one location
- Access to project information when you need it
- View project status, contacts, daily reports, field observations, submittals, punch lists, RFIs
- See project information in a dashboard or report format
- Download attachments and export views of project information



What does Kahua offer? con't

- Participate in the project management process by reviewing project documents and providing comments, "workflows"
- Upload and workflow project documents if needed
- Share project information with non-Kahua users
- Track the history of comments and decisions

How will I use Kahua?

View project information

Customers will have read-only access to the following applications in Kahua to view project information:



- Projects view details and status
- Daily Reports view daily activities
- Design Review view design review sets and comments
- Field Observations view comments
- Packaged Submittals view submittals and comments
- Punch Lists view list and comments
- RFIs view RFIs and comments
- Media Manager view photos
- Project Directory view core project team

Collaborate with project team members

Customers will have the ability to contribute to the following applications in Kahua:



- Communications draft/send memos, transmittals, letters
- File Manager upload/view documents
- Meetings create/edit meeting agendas/notes
- Dashboards create and view dashboards
- Tasks participate in the review of Design Reviews, RFIs, Submittals, and other apps teams work in collaboratively

NOTE:

- All Client Project Agreements (CPA) will be managed in the tool and approved via DocuSign. Customers will not access CPAs in Kahua
- Kahua provides project information on a project-by-project basis. Aggregate reporting not available.

How do I access Kahua?

Request Access

Create Multi-Factor Password

Login

Fill out and submit the Request Kahua Access Form. Be sure to include:

- A valid email address for yourself.
- A valid email address for the <u>GSA</u> Project Manager of the project you wish to access. Only one PM email is needed for a license. If you need access to more than one project: after you receive your license, contact the PM of the project to request access. Do not submit another license request.



You will receive an email from kahua.support to create a multifactor authentication password. Follow the instructions to create a 13-character password.

 NOTE: The MFA provider will change in the near future to Login.gov. Instructions for accessing Kahua using Login.gov will be emailed to licensed Kahua end users. You will receive an email from outbox@kahuafn.com with Subject: "Your new Kahua account is ready!". You can now log into your active Kahua account using your email address, MFA username and password. Login using launch.kahuafn.com. For quick access, it's recommended you bookmark the Kahua web URL.

 Note: If you do not see your project in Kahua, contact the GSA PM to check whether you have been added to the Project Directory and and the Customer Group.


