Introduction to June 2021

Air Sampling Reports

In a sampling event June 14 through June 25, 2021, air samples were collected at representative interior locations throughout the Goodfellow Federal Center. A total of 150 air samples, plus 18 blanks, were collected from within 14 buildings. Samples were analyzed for seven target metals: arsenic, barium, cadmium, chromium, lead, selenium, and silver. The testing was part of GSA's continual check for airborne levels of heavy metals by taking air samples inside tenant spaces at least twice a year.

No detectable levels of arsenic, barium, cadmium, chromium, lead, selenium, or silver were found in any air sample or blank. No further action is required at this time.
